You'll need:

2 colors of contrasting yarn in worsted weight: Main Color or MC (background) and Contrasting Color or CC (image)
4 mm needles

On the chart, red rows are worked in your MC; white rows are worked in your CC (the blue + green squares are there only so you can see what the image will look like; they do not reflect a color change).

Read the chart from bottom to top. Odd-numbered rows are read from right to left; even-numbered rows are read from left to right.

Cast on 40 stitches in MC. Work in K2P2 rib for 2.5 cm (1").

Follow the chart, changing colors after every 2nd row and alternating between MC and CC. Carry the yarn up the side.

Work in K2P2 rib for another 2.5 cm (1").

Bind off.

*pick up and knit 40 stitches on one side of the cloth. Knit the next row. Starting with the 3rd row, work in K2P2 rib for 2.5 cm (1"). Bind off. Repeat from * on the other side of the cloth.

Save the planet, one small step at a time!
